HAIR

Standard ballet hairstyle for girls is a secure, slicked-back bun with no bangs or wispies. Girls with short hair are still expected to pull hair back using clips and gel or spray.

Standard hairstyle for boys is short and neat, or pulled into a ponytail if hair is long.

Students in violation of hair code will be required to correct their hair prior to entering class. This means secure buns – absolutely NO loosely-tied hairdos. Absolutely NO ponytails.

Students are expected to bring adequate hair supplies with them to the studio. We recommend keeping a bag or other container with hair supplies in dance bags, along with hair spray or gel.

WARM-UPS

When students wear warm-ups, their technique is not fully visible to teachers. We keep studio temperatures comfortable, so there is no need for students to wear clothing over their dress code attire.

Absolutely no street wear is allowed in class including t-shirts and gym shorts. Proper ballet warm-ups may be allowed for the beginning of barre, but must be removed after the first couple exercises or when requested by the instructor. Proper ballet warm-ups may be used at rehearsals, especially in the theater. Absolutely no watches or jewelry in class with the exception of small secure earrings.

DRESSING ROOMS

Please note, the dressing room is in the rear of the studio and it is necessary to pass through the class area to reach it. There will be a 15 minute window in between classes to allow students to change without disrupting classes. Please note the following:

- **Students must arrive 15 minutes before class in time to change without disrupting the beginning of class.**
- Street Shoes must be removed in the entryway – they may not be used on the dance floor.
- Students must use the dressing room to change and keep their belongings. Ballet bags, cell phones, etc. must not be taken into the studio or left in the lobby. Food is not allowed in the dressing room.

GENERAL BEHAVIOIR

Students are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and disciplined manner. Excessive talking, rudeness, and other inappropriate behaviors will result in a student-parent-teacher conference.

We expect our students to show respect, kindness, and support to their fellow students and the utmost respect to faculty, staff and guest teachers at all times.
